Amerikaners is a community-driven organization established on 28 February 2025 in direct response to Executive Order 14204 issued by President Donald J. Trump, which created a pathway for Afrikaner refugees and other minority groups from South Africa to seek protection in the United States.

Founded by Sam Busà, Amerikaners serves as the voice of those minority communities who wish to pursue this opportunity offered by America. We exist to correct the narrative surrounding the South African situation, to serve, inform, and support our community through every stage of the migration process.

We are a movement led by people who personally understand the hopes and uncertainties of this path and are passionate about helping our countrymen find freedom from fear, exclusion and discrimination. Amerikaners collected **44,000+** signatures in one month for a Memorandum to Washington, delivered to the United States Mission on 24 March 2025. In it we:

- Expressed appreciation to President Trump and Secretaries Rubio and Noem;
- Accepted the offer for resettlement; and
- Committed to assimilate and perform.

We hosted press briefings and featured in **more than 80** international and national media publications, raising awareness of the challenges faced by Afrikaners and other minority groups in South Africa. We also addressed and corrected global media misconceptions suggesting that Afrikaners had rejected the offer of resettlement.

Amerikaners offer all services free of charge in support of the refugee programme for Afrikaners and other minority South Africans who wish to begin a new life in the United States.

These services include:

- Providing accurate information and guidance on the refugee process.
- Offering clear answers to common questions, helping to reduce uncertainty by clarifying procedures and timelines.
- Delivering regular updates, practical advice, and reliable resources through our social media platforms, email, and website to ensure applicants remain informed and supported.

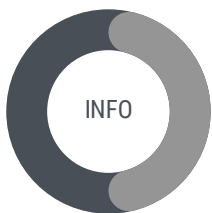
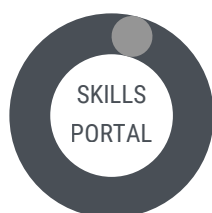

On July 4, 2025, Amerikaners launched its official website, marking a symbolic step in our shared journey toward freedom, renewal, and hope. The website serves as a central hub for accurate information about the Refugee Program, practical resources for navigating America, and community updates and communications.

In development is a jobs portal that allows approved South African refugees holding Employment Authorisation Documents (EADs) to submit their resumes for review by American businesses. In this way, we hope to assist families to get on their feet upon arrival.

Also ongoing is structuring ways to connect refugees with the hundreds of offers of help we have received from Americans.

We will continue to develop vital guidance on American life, culture and systems and bring together our community in localized forums to communicate with, support and encourage each other.

8 September 2025

On 8 September 2025, Amerikaners is announced as an Official Referring Partner for the U.S. Refugee Admissions Program (USRAP) involved in the following elements of the process in South Africa:

- Serving as a designated Department of State referral partner
- Gathering information from potential applicants to assess whether the case is eligible for referral to the USRAP
- Referring cases to the Department of State for USRAP access

Amerikaners launches its Referral Partner Website on October 7, 2025, offering vetted and accurate information as well as a referral process that can be used by the community hoping to make use of the Refugee Offer.
